

What's new at Town Park

Now that the weather is getting warmer, it's time to check out the many improvements to Town Park!

The Town Commissioners, along with the talented Dave and Mike from Public Works and our amazing Town Clerk Missy, have been hard at work to improve Town Park. The Park Board has installed new native landscaping and lighting along Gulf Boulevard, a sail shade over the children's playground, and a regulation size soccer net and a beach volleyball net. Residents can check out soccer and volley balls, and shuffleboard equipment from Town Hall. Last but not least, adult outdoor exercise equipment has been installed. Equipment includes a multi-trainer, rowing machine, stationary bicycle and elliptical machine. This equipment is designed for adults, and for safety reasons, children under the age of 13 should not be allowed on the equipment. Next up for the Town is the construction of a second pavilion along Gulf Boulevard. The pavilion is made possible by a generous donation from the family of Bob Yount, who was a long time Park Board member.
